

Minutes of the First Annual General Meeting of the Lincoln Golf Club Seniors Golf Society held on 21st November 1979 at the Clubhouse

1. The Minutes of the first meeting held in the Clubhouse at 10 am on 21st March 1979 were presented and agreed and duly signed by the Chairman.

2. Formation of Officers and Committee.

P Brown was elected to serve with the above.

3. A suggestion was put forward by the Convenor that an annual membership fee of £1.00 should be charged in order to defray expenses incurred through telephone calls and postal charges, any excess of income over expenditure being put towards the annual lunch. It was also suggested that a competition be played on the same day as the luncheon date. This was unanimously agreed.

4. It was agreed that competitions should take place on the second Wednesday of the month, instead of weekly, provided they did not interfere with match dates.

5. It was suggested that the Hon Secretary be approached to see if a small area of the notice board could be allocated to Senior Section Notices. This was agreed without hesitation.

6. One member pointed out that the Section should not be bogged down with too many matches. The Hon Secretary (H Cooper) mentioned that the Management Committee had agreed to Senior matches being played, provided that they were limited in number, but no concise number had been decided upon. The Convenor stated that the fixtures for 1980 were not yet complete, but it was thought that the same number would be played as in 1979.

The match results were:

7. The meeting was then closed and the Competition instituted, with twenty two members taking part.
