## Minutes of the Second Annual General Meeting of the Lincoln Golf Club Seniors Golf Section held on 10th December 1980 at the Clubhouse

7. The Convenor then reported to the meeting on the arranged matches for 1981. A considerable discussion took place on the number of matches and various venues. A majority vote proposed that the home matches be increased from five to seven for 1981 and that permission be sought from the General Committee for their consideration in this matter. Agreed times for matches was 9 for 9.30 start.

8. It was proposed and the motion carried that Foursomes be introduced in some matches. The Convenor reported to the meeting that the General Committee had agreed that one year in six the Seniors Section would be allowed to host and open meeting for six clubs, limited to 10 members each. The clubs involved would be:-Thonock, Carholme, Southcliffe, Canwick, Market Rasen, Blankney and Lincoln Golf Club.

9. Ted Thimbleby offered a trophy for a suitable competition. This generous offer was accepted by the members with grateful thanks.

The Chairman closed the meeting at 16.10 hours.
