Minutes of the Annual General Meeting 2023

The minutes of the 44th AGM held on Wednesday 15th November 2023 were adopted following a proposal by John Shaw, seconded by Phil Pearson. The membership agreed that the Minutes reflected a true record of the meeting.

Treasurer's Report

This is my sixth Annual report as your Treasurer and the fifth full accounting year in the role. The accounts prepared for this fiscal year continue to replicate a format that has been used for many years and affords comparisons to be made on both income and expenditure.

In terms of income in 2023/24 subscription and competitions income remained strong. Donations plus tight monitoring of "Frog" contributors resulted in another healthy Captain's Charity collection. Payments and costs for four Away Days were channelled through the Seniors Bank Account for ease of administration and these amounts cancel each other out.

Regarding expenditure, the Committee continued to recognise the excellent work of the Greens staff by a gratuity. Prizes paid out were 74% of entry fees, in line with the financial strategy. Costs were mitigated by the kind sponsorship of the prize balls by the Pro Shop. We continued to support LGC by sponsoring the 12th tee.

The larger than planned surplus is due to no bereavement payments needing to be paid, no required purchase of a Captain's sweater and this year no financially supported project with





LGC. The aim in the next financial year will be to reduce the overall surplus in line with the financial strategy.

It is recommended for 2024/25 that the Annual Subscription, competition entry fees, bereavement donations and all annual payments are unchanged.

Finally, my thanks go to my fellow Committee members for an excellent working relationship this year and to all Seniors for their support.

Consequently, we will play at their course in 2025 and at home in 2026. More detail to follow in due course.

I would like to express my thanks to my fellow committee members for their efforts this year, Paul and Paul have both put in an immense amount of effort to, hopefully, provide you with a programme which has been both testing and enjoyable.

I would finally like to say a particular thank you to both Simon Morris and Steve Friend for consistently getting up in the middle of the night. Simon for preparing the tea and coffee for every home match and Steve for setting up the Winter League virtually every week.
